



Sts. Michael, Gabriel, Raphael—Archangels—September 29

These heavenly messengers remind us that God, in His providence, sends His angels to guide, protect, and heal His people.

St. Michael the Archangel: Defender of the Faith--St. Michael is known as the great defender against the powers of evil. In the Book of Revelation, he leads the heavenly hosts in battle: *“Then war broke out in heaven; Michael and his angels battled against the dragon”* (Revelation 12:7). Catholics turn to Michael in times of spiritual struggle, invoking his strength and courage to stand firm in the truth.

St. Gabriel the Archangel: Herald of Good News--St. Gabriel is best known as the messenger who announced to Mary that she would bear the Son of God: *“Hail, full of grace! The Lord is with you”* (Luke 1:28). Gabriel’s role as God’s herald teaches us to be open to His call and to embrace our vocations with humility and trust.

St. Raphael the Archangel: Healer and Guide--St. Raphael appears in the Book of Tobit as a companion and healer. He reveals his mission by saying: *“I am Raphael, one of the*

seven angels who enter and serve before the Glory of the Lord” (Tobit 12:15). Raphael heals Tobit’s blindness and guides Tobias on his journey, making him a powerful intercessor for travelers, the sick, and all in need of God’s healing touch.

Why This Feast Matters Today--The Archangels remind us that the spiritual world is real, active, and close to us. In a culture that often dismisses or distorts angels, the Church invites us to honor these powerful servants of God who protect and intercede for us. Today is an opportunity to renew our devotion to the Archangels, asking them to guard our homes, guide our choices, and bring us closer to Christ. ***St. Michael, defend us. St. Gabriel, announce to us God’s plan. St. Raphael, heal and guide us. Holy Archangels, lead us to eternal life with God.***

The Holy Guardian Angels—October 2

The Catechism of the Catholic Church tells us: *“From its beginning until death, human life is surrounded by their watchful care and intercession”* (CCC 336). Guardian Angels are entrusted with guiding and protecting us. They are personal messengers of God’s love, uniquely appointed to each of us. The psalmist reminds us, *“For He commands His angels with regard to you, to guard you wherever you go”* (Psalm 91:11). This is not mere poetry; it is a profound truth. From childhood to old age, our guardian angel remains at our side, interceding for us before the throne of God and offering us silent inspirations toward holiness.

Companions on the Journey--Whether in moments of danger, confusion, or discouragement, we are never truly alone. The quiet nudge of our conscience, the sudden moment of clarity in prayer, or even the protection from unseen harm may be the gentle work of our angelic companion. The Feast of the Guardian Angels is an invitation to gratitude. God’s love is so particular, so personal, that He assigns an angel to walk with each of us through life’s trials and joys. In this we see His fatherly care: we are never abandoned, even when we feel isolated or weak. It is also a call to trust. Our guardian angel is not a distant figure but a vigilant friend. As Jesus Himself taught, *“See that you do not despise one of these little ones, for I say to you that their angels in heaven always look upon the face of my heavenly Father”* (Matthew 18:10). The angels behold God’s glory even as they accompany us, linking our earthly journey with heaven’s eternal praise.

Angel of God, my guardian dear, to whom God’s love commits me here, ever this day be at my side, to light and guard, to rule and guide. Amen.
