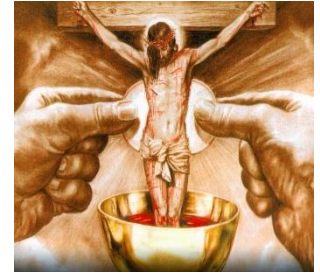

JULY—Month of the Precious Blood of Jesus!

The entire month of July is traditionally dedicated to the Precious Blood, encouraging Catholics to meditate on Jesus' profound sacrifice and the pouring out of His blood for humanity. This period invites deeper reflection on the mysteries of redemption and the Eucharistic celebration. We believe that through the shedding of His Blood, Jesus offered Himself as a perfect sacrifice to reconcile humanity with God and to atone for sin. The Precious Blood of Jesus is seen as the ultimate expression of God's love and mercy, as it was freely given for the forgiveness of sins and the salvation of souls. This devotion is powerful because it is the ultimate expression of Divine and Trinitarian love. It is the tangible sign of God's willingness to suffer and die for the sake of our salvation. Jesus' Blood is the victory over sin and death achieved through His resurrection. We believe that the Eucharist is the true Body and Blood of Jesus Christ. Through the Sacrament of the Eucharist, we receive the Precious Blood of Jesus, nourishing us spiritually and uniting us more closely to Christ. We believe that devotion to the Precious Blood has the power to deliver believers from all spiritual harm and the whiles of the devil who wants our destruction. We often invoke the Precious Blood for strength, healing, and deliverance for every evil and temptation. **Blood of Christ, save us! Blood of Christ, purify us!**
